## **GENERAL** Ceiling Fans turned OFF and dusted. ☐ Replace any burnt out light bulbs and make sure they're the same color temperature in each room. Computers turned OFF, Laptops closed, cords and cables neat and hidden if possible. Blinds and shutters cleaned and open (raised). Cell phone and tablet chargers put away or hidden. Lamp shades straightened and dust free. Hide all valuable items. ☐ Pictures on the walls should be straight (level). Remove small throw rugs including door mats. ☐ Hide all waste baskets/trash cans throughout home (kitchen, bathrooms, bedrooms). Minimize clutter to help make rooms look open and larger. Remove seasonal decorations from both interior and Remove all personal items that you'd like to not be exterior so photos are not dated. photographed. Windows clean and streak free. ☐ Put away personal photos to help create a blank canvas. **KITCHEN** ANIMALS/PETS ☐ All counter areas cleaned and cleared of appliances (hide Please have pets safely restrained on a leash, in a kennel, or off site during appointment. toasters, blenders, microwaves if possible). Dishes, sponges, dish rags and hand towels put away, sinks Put away and hide any food and water dishes, toys, beds, etc., both inside and outside. Paper napkins and paper towel rolls removed. Hide cat litter box and any scratching posts or towers. ☐ Refrigerator doors and sides should be cleared of magnets, Turn on pool/spa lights if possible. papers and artwork. Pickup any animal waste from exterior of your home. **BEDROOMS EXTERIOR** □ All clothes should be hung up or put away. Put away hoses, tools, yard equipment, toys and any other Rooms should be clean with beds made. Vehicles should be removed from the driveway and street Walk-in closets should be free from clutter. area directly in-front of home. Personal items should be hidden. Driveway, pathways, and patios should be cleared of snow. leaves, and other debris. **BATHROOMS** Ensure exterior is clear of trash and debris. Lawn mowed and clippings/leaves swept away. Mirrors and glass clean and streak free. Shrubbery in front of the house trimmed. Remove all items from counter tops, sinks, showers, and Remove any empty flower pots. Remove plunger and cleaning tools. Remove all yard signs (home security, school, political, etc.). Remove all rugs and mats. Put trash/recycle bins in garage or out of sight. TWILIGHT PREP (IF SCHEDULED) Pool/spa cover should be removed if possible. Water features should be turned on if possible. ☐ Turn on all interior and exterior lighting including lamps. Open and raise blinds and shutters.

Turn on pool/spa lights if possible.

☐ Light fire pit if possible.
